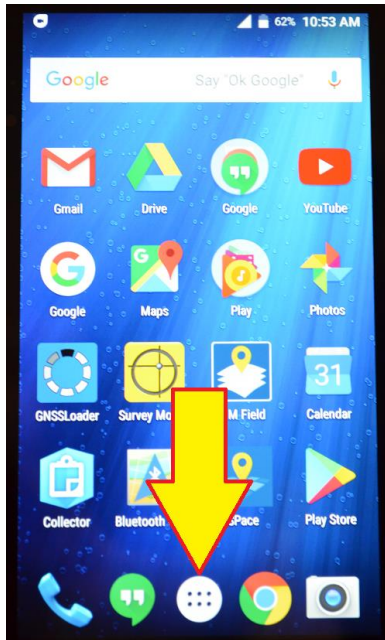

Step-by-step instructions for installing a DAC card (the GSM cards sold by iGage) in an SP20.

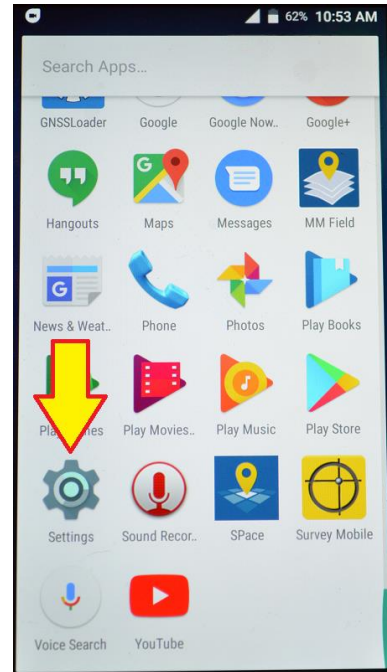
Instructions

Install the DAC card under the battery. Use the full-sized card, not the Mini or Micro punches.

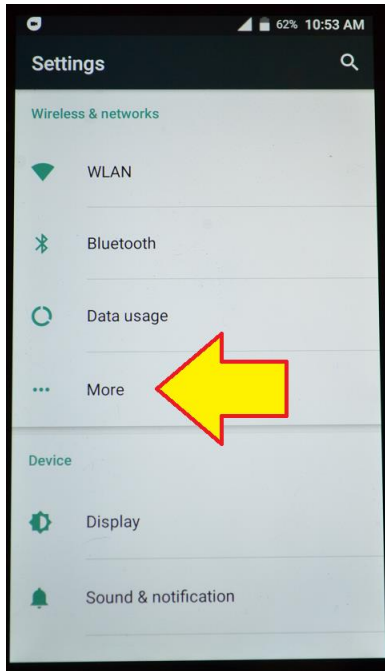
Turn on the SP20, click on the '☰' button from the main home screen:



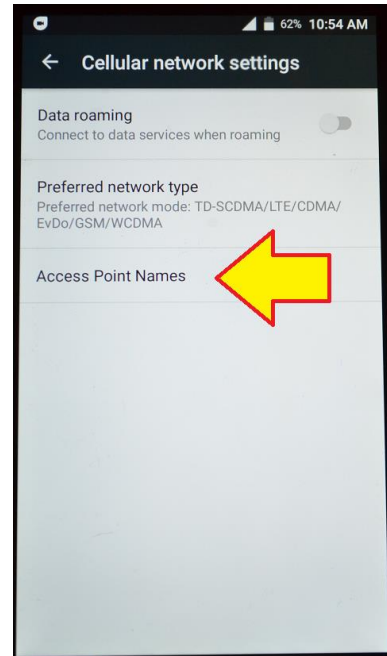
Drag down and click on the 'Settings' gear:



Click on '... More':

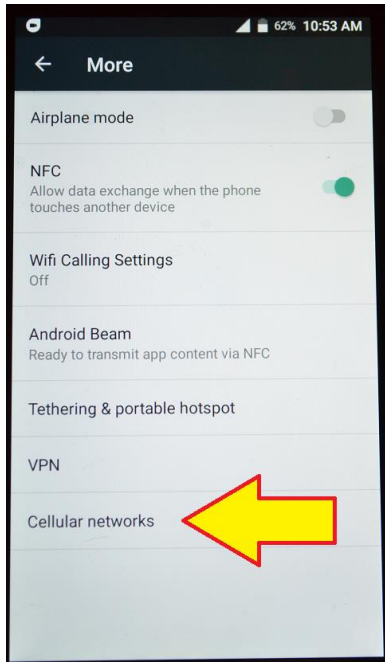


Click on 'Access Point Names':

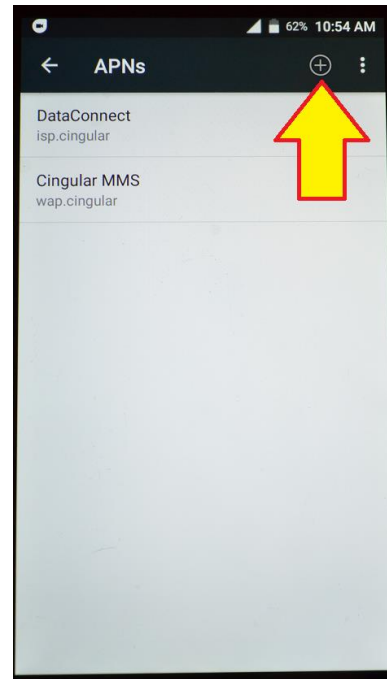

Click on 'Cellular Networks':

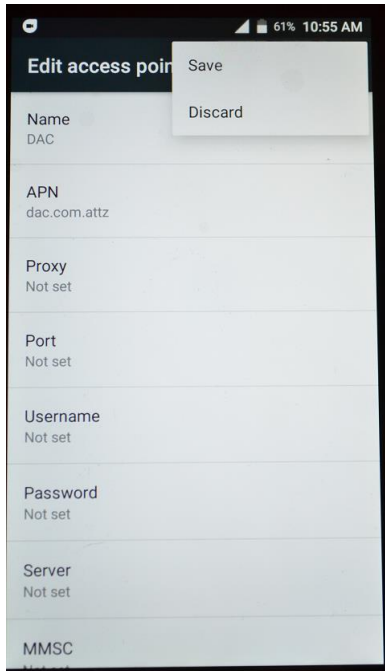


Click on the 'Add' button (+):

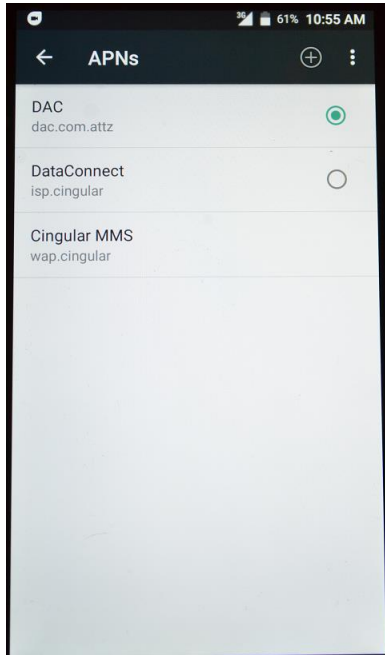


Set the Name to 'DAC'. Set the APN to 'dac.com.attz'. Then click on the '...' button and

click on 'Save':



Click on the 'DAC' entry radio (round) button to select the new APN. The SP20 will automatically re-connect using the new APN:



Use the back button to return to the home menu, turn off Wi-Fi, then start the Chrome browser and navigate to a site to make sure the

card is provisioned and works:
